# HOLMES COUNTY SCHOOL BOARD BUDGET HEARING/REGULAR SESSION AUGUST 1, 2016

The Holmes County School Board held a Public Hearing and met in Regular Session on Monday, August 3, 2015 at 5:05 p.m. in the Board Room at 701 East Pennsylvania Avenue in Bonifay. Board Members present: Sid Johnson - Chair, Shirley Owens – Vice-Chair, Debbie Kolmetz, Alan Justice, and Rusty Williams. Also present: Superintendent Eddie Dixon, Board Attorney Jeff Goodman, Administrators Donnita Butorac and Finance Officer Kelly Leavins. Adrienne Odum, Resource Officer was also present.

Public Hearing was opened with Sid Johnson request to adopt the agenda. Rusty Williams made a motion to adopt the agenda for tentative millage rates and budget hearing for the 2016-2017 fiscal year.
